Dear Parent(s) and Guardian(s):

Do you have a computer at home but no internet service? Our High School Library has joined a creative program with OCM BOCES School Library System to provide internet access to those students that do not have access at home.

The program allows students to borrow a device which acts as a "hotspot", providing internet access for students to complete their school work. Students must have their own computer to use the hotspot. **The device is intended for students who do not have access to internet at their home.**

The device will connect to the Verizon network, allowing 500 mb per day of data use and will shut down once that limit is hit. There is a web filter in place and the device will automatically turn off between the hours of 11pm and 6am.

The hotspot device may be signed out at the end of the school day and must be returned to the library at the beginning of the next school day. Please note, there are only two devices, so students should have a backup plan in the event that both devices are already on loan.
